I think it's time I show a prophet now. A so called prophet of God.

Kim Clement is a self proclaimed "Prophet" He also plays music. And he mixes New Age ideas and beliefs while claiming to speak for God, saying what will happen in the future. Yet, many of his prophecies have not come to pass when they should have. Keep these verses in mind when hearing prophecies from prophets:

Deuteronomy 18:21-22 "And if you say in your heart, 'How shall we know the word which the LORD has not spoken?--when a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him'"

Matthew 24:23-27 "For false Christ's and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect. See, I have told you beforehand. So, if they say to you, 'Look, he is in the wilderness,' do not go out. If they say, 'Look, he is in the inner rooms,' do not believe it. For as the lightning comes from the east and shines as far as the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man."

Keep those verses in mind ALWAYS when someone comes around claiming to speak for God and says all these prophecies and signs, especially when he/she says when they will be fulfilled.

Not only that, but when a prophet is giving prophecies of what God has shown them, wouldn't it make sense to hear the same prophecies coming from other so called prophets of God? As more proof that maybe something is up? That maybe God is using a bunch of people to tell us all something? Let's take a look at much of the many failed prophecies of Kim Clement. And what's really interesting is, he's completely aware that plenty of people have called him a false prophet, yet he doesn't care. He has a bunch of prophecies on his website at kimclementvault.com which you can read and determine yourselves if he's telling the truth.

Here's some of his false or failed prophecies:

Some people claim Kim Clement foretold about 9/11 on July 25, 1996. This article explains why that can't be.

"God wants us to go to the back streets. He wants to have a cure for AIDS. He said it's going to be by the year 2002, there's going to be a cure for AIDS. Well, somebody said "Well, those homosexuals deserve to have AIDS." No they don't. You deserve to die, but Jesus died for you 2000 years ago. I don't think anybody deserves to die. There's gonna be a cure and there's gonna

be a Christian that is a scientist that's gonna come across a discovery. (Praise the Lord, 12/26/2000)

“Hannah is going to prophesy: I can see the dead being raised to life, I can see sick being healed. I can see the poor saying I am rich and the weak saying I am strong. 2007, I see it, that is the Word of the Lord. 2007 I can see it, that is the Word of the Lord, 2007 I can see it, that is the promise of God. I can see children moving in the street, I see schools being changed in a moment, I see colleges being turned upside down. I see mothers and fathers coming together, I can see families being restored. Babies being healed, children coming back, I can see prisoners being set free, I see life being instilled into those that do not know life, life is being restored. The dead will be raised again, sicknesses will be healed. Cancer, cancer, HIV will be healed in a moment. I see cures for diseases in 2007, cures for incurable diseases. 2007 is our year, this is the Year of Jubilee. This is the Year of Jubilee, that is the Word of the Lord. This is the Year of Jubilee, that is the Word of the Lord.” (November 26, 2006 - Hollywood, CA)

It's 2012 and AIDS is still around. So is cancer and HIV. And I haven't heard news of all those things Clement said back in 2007. Clement failed twice on claiming a cure for AIDS would be found.

“Osama Bin Laden said that in 35 days America (he was prophesying, predicting) would be abolished, wiped out because he has a plan for 35 days. And the word of the Lord came to me and said, You prophesy that the very thing that he said and predicted for this Nation is reversed, I'm going to bring him out in 35 days. There is a resurrection day coming over this Easter. This Easter will be one of the greatest Easters this nation has ever celebrated. Why? Because there will be a resurrection of the dead, speaking spiritually of revelation that has died, of prophetic words that have died and been buried in the ground. This Easter, not only will I bring your greatest enemy out, but I will also bring about a severe judgment against the powers and the principalities that have come against my servants, against my people. There shall be a judgment.” 1/12/2004

Nope! Nothing big happened back then. And look what he says in that same prophecy:

“Alzheimer's has come against too many of God's people; the prophetic word of the Lord is coming to you tonight. Alzheimer's, Diabetes, Parkinson's disease, rare bone and lung diseases; these five things will suddenly come to the surface with incredible discoveries and it will begin this year.” (1/12/2004)

Once again, nothing! Thousands of people suffering from those things would really love it if cures were found! But the cures didn't come like they were supposed to according to Kim Clement. I really wished all Christians would be quick to write down those prophecies that sound

too good to be true for them to come to pass, so they will remember them and see how false Clement is. Thankfully, Kim Clement was nice enough to keep most of his prophecies recorded on his website for reference. Here's some more false prophecies.

Kim Clement: "Somebody called the other day and said that I had prophesied that Bill Clinton would not be the president, that there'd be a new president. Well, I never said that, and I never prophesied that. I said the president of this, the final president of this century would be Spirit-filled, would be born-again and would be praying for this nation and lead them into the millennium with prayer. God has predicted somebody in the White House will do something big. Favor is coming not to the White House, but from the White House. Favor is coming towards the people of God...So, I still see a tremendous breakthrough in the White House. There is a new president coming to the White House. There is a new president coming to the White House, with a new Spirit...God said that He's coming back for a glorious church without spot or blemish. That church has been born right now. That church is being born right now. That church is in the making right now. That church is in the making, whether we like it or not."

Paul Crouch: "Also, let me ask you to repeat again: if I understood what you said, by the end of this century, the president, whoever he may be, is going to be born-again, Spirit-filled, and will be leading our nation in prayer. Now, did I understand that correctly?"

Kim Clement: "Absolutely, and I've said that all along, and I believe that with all my heart, and I've prophesied that and I'll re-prophecy that if I have to tonight." (Praise the Lord, 2-4-1997)

So was Kim Clement talking about George W. Bush? Here's more of what Kim Clement has said of George W. Bush.

"The Spirit of God has announced that, you have looked at candidates for the next four years. I have looked at a man after my own that will pray. I am looking and have searched for a man who would pray in the house called White, and I have found that man. He shall pray. He shall pray sturdily, powerfully, until the year 2006...and a great storm shall rise upon America. But because of the prayers of George W. Bush, I will save this country from a damage and a destruction upon your economy and upon your children." (October 24, 2004)

Though George W. Bush claimed to be Christian and many in America believed it, sadly he really isn't. Not just that he choose to go to war with Iraq over lies on WMD information, not just that he signed the Patriot Act, which made innocent people suspected of being terrorists and take their rights away. How about the fact that he was a member of the Skull and Bones fraternity while attending Yale and even joined the Bohemian Grove? There's too much information about those 2 clubs to put here, but look them up and you'll see the pure evil that goes on in these places and find how corrupt most of the high level politicians are. Most Republicans during the 20th century have attended the Bohemian Grove and still call themselves Christian in public.

"For years, I have felt the need to prophesy about a President who would rise up against the 'beast of the east' and deal with him. In 1996 God spoke through me about an attack in the USA. I saw an act of violence as terrorists flew over New York. Since then, the years to follow would

provoke numerous prophecies regarding a war and the fact that God would raise up a President who would be a true Christian and who would pray. He also showed me that this President would deal with four nations; nations that supported and harbored terrorists. In some of these prophecies the words "Burning Bush" were used, indicating that it would be President Bush who would be the instrument of this cleansing. On April 1st 2001, I said "America prepare yourself, you will go to war". Subsequently, the Spirit began to share some of the details about the possible length of the battle and the outcome. I spoke about certain attacks planned against the soldiers and the fact that God would protect them so that not one of them would be inflicted. I believe with all of my heart that America is in the perfect will of God. A tyrant lives, and yet there are people in this nation shouting the odds about the instrument that God has chosen as his battle-axe - the President of the United States of America." Was Kim Clement talking about 9/11 and the Iraq war? Even so, the fact that he said that no Americans would die from this war is a big lie!

"Between August, September and October there is a window open for families in America for atheism to be destroyed and for legalism to be destroyed and for religion to be destroyed." (January 30, 2005 - Oklahoma City, OK)

"I will raise from rock groups, from rap artists, I will raise from sportsmen and they will speak out the word that the musicians and the rappers already experienced in prophesying without the Spirit, but now they are going to prophesy with the Spirit and with the fire and that will raise up a generation that shall be filled with the fire of God and consumed with his seal.

Be aware of this, 50, 50, 50! Maybe you have no idea who this is. But now is the greatest voice in this nation. It shall come to pass that 50 shall be known as 50 because there are no cents. For there is one thing that shall happen. The Spirit shall come upon him. And they shall say, is he amongst the prophets as well? Then Eminem shall say, I know that I was born for this, I know that I was born for this. There is one more. He is unknown but shall become famous overnight He shall be in darkness for a short period and 50 and Eminem shall overshadow him and there shall be a three fold chord that will not be broken. Why am I saying this? Because America you have let your children go. You've let them go because you've not disciplined them. But I will bring them back swiftly. Because you know why? I have raised up a President to watch over the nation. Now I'm raising up watchmen on the wall in the music world so that your children will come out saying, something happened when I said those words. I began to speak in other languages the mysterious God of the earth shall take your children and this generation and raise them up as Samuel's, David's, Jeremiah's and Isaiah's, Obadiah's in this generation. This year there shall be a joining of networks, ABC being one of them, and they shall have a section where Christ will be glorified, says the Lord. The media shall never be the same. Sure, a lot of people did look up John 3:16 thanks to Tim Tebow and the apparent coincidence of Tebow throwing that football a total of 316 yards and high amount of Twitter messages. But is there revival and repentance all across the U.S. because of him? I don't see it yet. I think it's possible that God can use Tim Tebow to help people get to know Jesus, but Kim Clement seems to use Tim Tebow as an excuse to fulfill his prophecies in the past, maybe to improve his credibility as a prophet. The rest of what Clement said in those 2 prophecies don't appear to have come to pass though. A prophet's prophecies are supposed to be 100% accurate always!

I've noticed some other things about false prophets like Kim Clement. They always try to somehow use prophecy mixed in with current events or famous people, claiming certain signs are signs of God when there's no relation, they always claim that "This year is the year of..." as some empty words designed to tickle their listeners ears to always hear good news. They are always saying we will be blessed, we'll have victory, to give the false illusion that things will always be great, to make everyone happy. Even when the whole world is falling apart now, they don't give realistic warnings about the state of the world and a call to repentance.

"The idea that we have to wait until we get to heaven to get our crown is a whole lot of garbage. We will receive our crowns here on earth. How can we be kings on this earth without our crowns? ...We are meant to rule and to reign here on the earth." Kim Clement (Doctrinal Statement September 26, 2001)

Uhhh no, it's Jesus that will reign here on Earth eventually. For 1000 years.

"I do not believe that you must be born again to obtain salvation. I believe there is a distinction" Kim Clement (Doctrinal Statement September 26, 2001)

John 3:3 disagrees when Jesus says "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Kim Clement: " The church, with its prophetic mantle can actually win a lot more people to the Lord because of the idea that we are presenting right now, and that is that every one of you were born and formed and sent upon by God for something great. The prophetic makes you aware of something that is already present in you that you've not seen..... Everyone that's born, God has placed something special inside. It's our responsibility as preachers of the New Millennium to bring out the treasure that's already there..... I'm telling you there's going to be some ignoramus coming to meetings, into our meetings, the New Millennium church, that's not focusing on the sin and trying to force them to repent and make them afraid because they're going to go to hell, and they're going to discover 'there's a glory, there's a beauty inside of me' that only Christ can bring out by the power of His breath and His resurrection. And that's what way the church is going

Matt Crouch: "Wow. I want to mention real quickly. Wow. You know, that's basically 180

degrees from the way it's been taught. (Praise The Lord (TBN), February 4, 1997.)

Kim Clement is referring to the “treasure”, which he believes is inside of our hearts. And he seems to have forgotten these verses:

"Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour? What if God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory," Rom 9:21-23
